Bliss Point plunges us into the ever-accelerating rhythm of food supply and the emergence of new techno-capitalist processes. The film guides us from dark kitchens and food advertising sets to AI-managed warehouses. A delivery driver cycles across the city to a makeshift trailer where workers flip burgers. Algorithm powered robots buzz through a sprawling grid of crates and 3D printers stack layers of computer-generated data to produce food alternatives. Drawing from the concept of optimal palatability, *Bliss Point* reveals the entanglement of automation and human labour, and the ways in which the aesthetics and the politics of food intersect. Together with *Future Foods* (2021) and *Agrilogistics* (2022), it completes a trilogy on scopic food regimes.*



CAT: *Bliss Point* ens submergeix en l'accelerat ritme del subministrament d'aliments mitjançant nous processos tecnocapitalistes. La pel·lícula ens endinsa a l'interior de cuines fantasma, platós de publicitat o magatzems gestionats per IA. Un repartidor recorre la ciutat en una bicicleta elèctrica fins a arribar a un contenidor industrial on es cuinen hamburgueses. En un magatzem, robots controlats per algorismes processen comandes de forma automatitzada, mentre en un laboratori s'imprimeixen filets vegans en 3D. Partint del concepte de palatabilitat òptima, *Bliss Point* revela les relacions entre l'automatització i el treball humà i les formes en què l'estètica i la política del menjar s'entrecreuen. Juntament amb *Future Foods* (2021) i *Agrilogistics* (2022), completa una trilogia sobre règims alimentaris escòpics.

ES: *Bliss Point* nos sumerge en el acelerado ritmo del suministro de alimentos mediante nuevos procesos tecno-capitalistas. La película nos adentra al interior de cocinas fantasma, platós de publicidad o almacenes gestionados por IA. Un repartidor recorre la ciudad en una bicicleta eléctrica hasta llegar a un contenedor industrial donde se cocinan hamburguesas. En un almacén, robots controlados por algoritmos procesan cestas de la compra de forma automatizada, mientras que en un laboratorio se imprimen filetes veganos en 3D. Partiendo del concepto de palatabilidad óptima, *Bliss Point* revela las relaciones entre la automatización y el trabajo humano, y las formas en que la estética y la política de la comida se entrecruzan. Junto a *Future Foods* (2021) y *Agrilogistics* (2022), completa una trilogía sobre regímenes alimentarios escópicos.







Bliss Point completes a triogy on the relationships between **Moving Images, Technologies and Ecologies of Food Regimes.**



Future Foods (2021) 21 min

Future Foods looks at the making of plastic food at the workshops of Replica LTD, one of the few UK prop manufacturers for films, advertisements and displays. The perception of food, its appealingness and palatability come into play through the observation of these hand-crafted manufacturing processes. A phone conversation with the CEO of a Finnish future foods' start-up introduces us to a cutting edge technology consisting of the production of a new protein generated from water, electricity and CO2 captured from the air. 'Solein' is a new technology that speculates with a near future without agriculture and land use effects.



Agrilogistics (2022) 21 min

Agrilogistics looks at recent technological transformations in contemporary industrial agriculture. Tulip bulbs, chrysanthemum stems and vine tomatoes are processed through cameras, feeding datasets that regulate their own growth. During the day, the greenhouse is a cinematic device, an automated film set optimized for the mass production of fruits and flowers. At night, the factory stops: without an inside or an outside, the greenhouse becomes an oneiric chamber where plants, animals and machines form new entanglements.

Gerard Ortín Castellví (b. 1988, Barcelona) is an artist, filmmaker and researcher. He is a mentor at UCL Creative Documentary by Practice MFA. His works have been shown in places like Tate Modern (London), Whitechapel Gallery (London), Fundació Joan Miró (Barcelona), Centre Georges Pompidou (Paris), Anthology Film Archives (NY), Venice Architecture Biennale (Venice), and in festivals like Visions du Réel (Nyon), Open City Film Festival (London), Cinéma du Réel (Paris), KVIFF (Karlovy Vary), HKIFF (Hong Kong) and Berlinale (Berlin).
